





Coaches-All coaches of The MAC staff are members of the United States Figure Skating (USFS) and the Professional Skating Association (PSA). The PSA is the organization for the teaching and performing professionals, which provides and promotes the education and certification of figure skating coaches. Ratings are achieved in Figures, Free Style, Dance, Group, Program Director, Synchronized, Choreography and Moves in the Field (MIF). Our coaches have sent skaters to the Jr. National and National Level Competitions.

Curriculum-The MAC coaching staff follows the curriculum of the USFS "Learn-to-Skate" program. Skaters advance from Snowplow Sam to Basic 8 then they may select areas of interest from Free Style, Dance, Power, Hockey, and Synchronized.



The USFS is the national governing body for the sport of figure skating in the United States and is recognized by the International Skating Union (ISU) and the United States Olympic Committee. Through the Fort Wayne Ice Skating Club participants can become a member of the USFS. The benefits of becoming a member of U.S. Figure Skating through the club include:

-  Opportunity to become a member of the U.S. World Figure Skating, Synchronized Skating Team or Olympic Figure Skating




